

NBTC Laura Secord Independent Hike Notes

Distance: 32km

Trail: Laura Secord Homestead, Queenston to DeCew Heritage Park, Thorold

Start at the Laura Secord Homestead, 29 Queenston St, Queenston. Come out of the parking lot turning left onto Partition St. Turn right onto Queenston St. Follow Queenston St to Mackenzie Printery and Newspaper Museum. Climb the stairs straight ahead and follow the path, crossing York St. Trail continues around to the left. Take a right at the battlefield marker (may be vandalized). Cross the Niagara Parkway and then stay on the right of the parkway up to the Bruce Trail cairn in the Queenston Heights parking lot. Follow the white blazes the rest of the way to DeCew Heritage Park.

Note: From time to time, you will see Friends of Laura Secord signs. This is not the same trail as the Bruce Trail. The two trails overlap at times. If there is a choice of direction, always follow the white blazes.

This is a Friends of Laura Secord sign, NOT the Bruce Trail.



This is a Bruce Trail sign. It will always have at least one white blaze. One blaze indicates go straight ahead. Two blazes indicate a turn. The top blaze indicates the direction to turn. This one indicates turning to the left.
